2020 brought many challenges to everyone. For a patient in treatment, COVID-19 was an additional challenge.

Our services continued every day, because patients needed us.

We made changes in protocols to increase our safety measures that were already in place to better serve patients and their family members.

Outreach increased significantly through digital platforms.
Meditations, Yoga, Tobacco Cessation, Exercise Classes and even Counseling was provided when needed.

Hope Cancer Resources employs a highly-professional staff which includes oncology social workers licensed with the State of Arkansas and certified by the Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board, a certified medical Spanish interpreter, two certified tobacco treatment specialists, one who is also a certified personal trainer and certified exercise specialist. Our patient transportation program provides access to care for patients' cancer treatment as needed. We also provide education to help a patient during and after their treatment. Financial assistance is provided for prescription medications, nutritional supplements, dental care, gas cards, as well as everyday living expenses to alleviate some of the financial stress a patient and their family may face.

Believing emotional support is essential for healthy survivorship, we offer counseling services ranging from a kind word or listening ear to one-on-one, couples or family counseling sessions with a licensed mental health professional. Hope Cancer Resources also provides emotional support in group settings.

Our Wellness Center for Hope was established to help enhance the quality of life in survivors and caregivers by restoring physical activity, optimizing nutrition and developing healthy behaviors and lifestyles.

In addition, Hope Cancer Resources empowers the community by providing cancer education for public schools, churches, businesses and civic organizations in our region. Education includes sun and UV safety, tobacco prevention and cessation, and healthy lifestyle behaviors to lower cancer risk.
