2021 continued to bring many challenges to patients and caregivers as they were navigating their personal cancer journey.

Our services continued every day, because patients needed us.

Our social workers assessed 3,679 newly diagnosed patients and provided individualized resources to meet their needs.

Meditations, Yoga, Tobacco Cessation, and Exercise Classes were provided in person and through a digital platform when needed. Hope Cancer Resources employs a highly-professional staff which includes oncology social workers licensed with the State of Arkansas and certified by the Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board, a medical Spanish interpreter, two certified tobacco treatment specialists, one who is also a certified personal trainer and cancer exercise specialist. Our patient transportation program provides access to care for patients' cancer treatments as needed. We also provide education to help a patient during and after their treatment. Financial assistance is provided for prescription medications, nutritional supplements, dental care, gas cards, as well as everyday living expenses to alleviate some of the financial stress a patient and their family may face.

Believing emotional support is essential for healthy survivorship, we offer counseling services ranging from a kind word or listening ear to one-on-one, couples or family counseling sessions with a licensed mental health professional. Hope Cancer Resources also provides emotional support in group settings.

Our Wellness Center for Hope was established to help enhance the quality of life in survivors and caregivers by restoring physical activity, optimizing nutrition and developing healthy behaviors and lifestyles.

In addition, Hope Cancer Resources empowers the community by providing cancer education for public schools, churches, businesses and civic organizations in our region. Education includes sun and UV safety, tobacco prevention and cessation, and healthy lifestyle behaviors to lower cancer risk.
